Coleman Vote Results

I want to pass along the unofficial results for the vote on Coleman Avenue. We have not yet received all ballots and will therefore wait a few days to officially certify the results, but so far the turnout is as follows:

- 98 YES (61%)
- 60 NO (37%)
- 3 abstain (2%)
- 1 no vote

This very closely resembles both the response rate and the percentages of the previous vote in March and also represents more than 50% of the neighborhood overall. If the result stays the same, as it is likely to, we will hope to pass along word to the neighborhood this week. We will also begin the very early stages of looking for funding and planning for the project, though this process will take time.

Thank you for all your assistance throughout this process in engaging the Menlo Oaks community and involving so many in our process.

Neighborhood News

Measure C

Measure C passed with a 76.2% margin. Following the Special Board Meeting on May 10th, the district is expecting to be able to rescind the preliminary layoff notices of teachers and other certificated employees and mitigate the reduction of services by classified and administrative employees.

The additional revenue from Measure C will help address the 5.1% enrollment growth for the 2010-11 school year, enable the District to accommodate the substantial growth that we project at Hillview School during the next seven years, ensure that the District can continue to benefit from reasonable class sizes at all grade levels, and help maintain a consistent level of enrichment services within the elementary schools.

Recent reports estimate that 23,000 teachers in the state and 10% of teachers of San Mateo County teachers have been laid off. It will take years for many districts to recover from the substantial loss of revenue and the severe reductions of educational programs and services.
